

Training: Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational (FRO)

**Rescheduled:

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is required for personnel who might respond to releases or potential releases of hazardous substances as part of the initial response to the site for the purpose of protecting nearby persons, property, or the environment. This typically includes fire, law and EMS responders.

Content will include: Introduction to Hazardous Materials at the First Responder Operational Level; Hazardous Materials Recognition and Safety; Safety, Isolation, and Notifications; Command/ Introduction to Scene Management; Identification and Hazard Assessment; Action Plans; Protective Equipment and First Responder Limitations; Containment and Protective Actions; Toxicology; Decontamination; Agency Coordination; The Safe and Competent Hazardous Materials Response Process.

Saturday and Sunday, April 17 & 18 from 0830 to 1730 each day at the Hayfork Fire Hall
